World Wide Web Citations

Works on the World Wide Web are cited just like printed works but you must include information in your citation that directs readers to the correct URL or INTERNET address (type in angle brackets). If your source lacks page numbers, you have no choice but to omit that from your citation, but if the WEB cite does include numbering, cite those in your reference. Page numbering on the WEB or what appears on the computer screen is not the same as pagination on your printout. NOTE: The date of access goes before the URL or address and in military style (26 September 2007).
