for children ages birth to six.

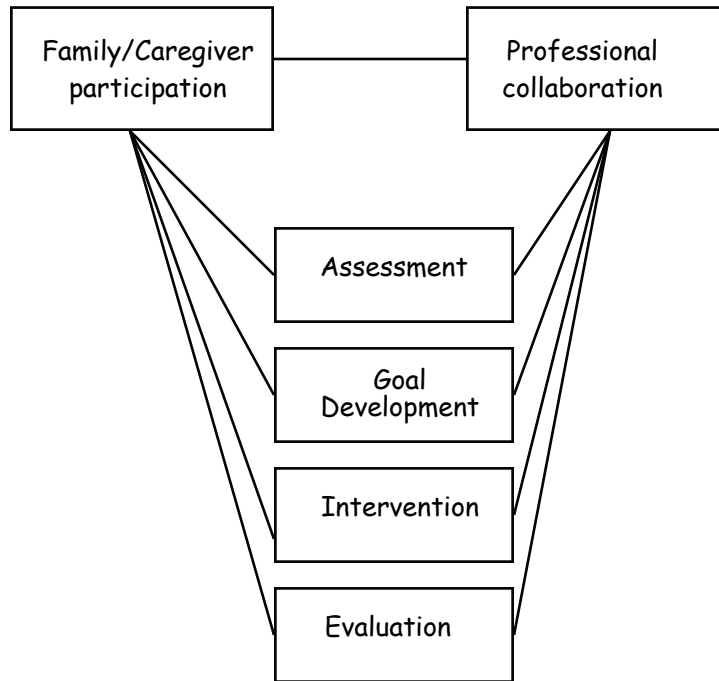

### **The AEPS Curriculum is an Activity-Based Intervention Approach**

- Child-directed activity-based intervention
- Emphasizes child's strengths, interests, and emerging skills
- Embeds children's individual goals and objectives in routine, planned or child-initiated activities
- Incorporates natural consequences to develop life skills
- Designed to meet the needs of all areas of development: fine motor, gross motor, adaptive behavior, cognitive, communication, and social skills
- Assessment at entrance and on-going until the exit of program

**The curriculum reflects our mission statement.**

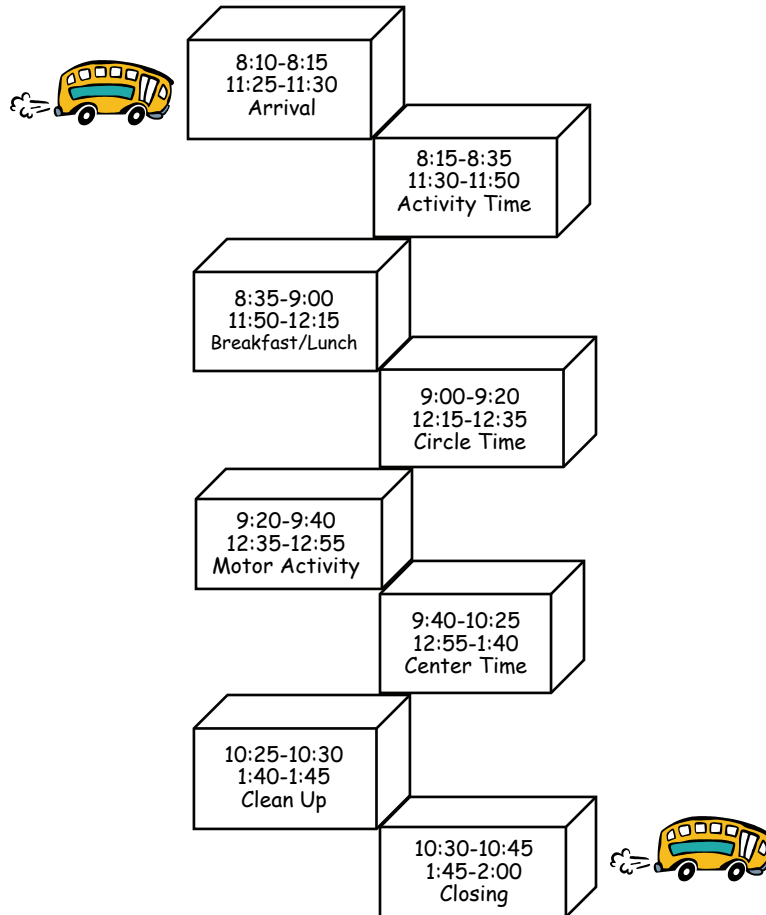

The AEPS provides a direct link between assessment, goal development, intervention, and evaluation. Because the AEPS curriculum capitalizes on daily routines, it is designed for use in the home, community-based preschool or child care settings. Family/caregiver participation and professional collaboration are critical components to the success of the program.
